**Sparkling**-----  
*Prosecco, Bele Casei NV, Veneto* 9.00  
 Citrus flower aromas and a persistent almond-flavored finish. A refreshing starter.  
*Gruet, "Blanc de Noirs" NV, New Mexico* 9.00  
 Rich toasty character with berry aromas and creamy texture.  
*Moscato d' Asti, Bosio 2008 Piemonte* 7.50  
 Lively, fruity, and sweet; a great apéritif or alternative to White Zinfandel.

**White**-----  
*Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Fontaleoni 2008 Toscana* 7.00  
 Light, crisp, and bone dry with flavors of nuts and dried fruit.  
*Sauvignon Blanc, Carl Roy 2006 Napa* 7.50  
 Guava, apple and crisp minerality dominate the palate, with a lush and refreshing mouthfeel.  
*Chardonnay, Round Hill 2007 California* 6.50  
 Ripe pear aromas and flavors combine with crisp acidity and a nice viscous body.  
*Chardonnay, Germano 2007 Piedmont* 9.50  
 Focused minerality is contrasted with distinct aromas of apricot and lemon zest.  
*Verdicchio, Brunori "Le Gemme" 2007 Marche* 7.50  
 A wine of structure and finesse, with beautiful aromatics and a lovely, nutty finish.  
*Pinot Grigio, Lagaria 2008 Friuli* 6.50  
 Light, crisp, and minerally with a floral bouquet. A great starter wine.

**Red**-----  
*Chianti, Stellina di Notte 2007 Toscana* 7.50  
 Aromas of dark berries and cassis. Full-bodied and earthy, yet elegant and supple.  
*Syrah, Renwood "Select Series" 2004 Sierra Foothills* 7.00  
 Medium-bodied, has moderate depth of cherry fruit and an earthy finish with modest tannins.  
*Pinot Noir, Grayson Cellars 2007 Central Coast* 7.00  
 Palate has vibrant flavors of cherry compote and baking spices with a balanced finish.  
*Montepulciano d' Abruzzo, Montori 2007 Abruzzo* 7.00  
 Spicy red berry fruit with mellow tannins and an almondy background.  
*Cabernet Sauvignon, Sawbuck 2007 Mendocino* 8.00  
 Aromas of red raspberries and chocolate are prevalent with hints of toasty oak and spice.  
*Merlot, Chalone 2006 Monterey* 7.50  
 Soft yet full-bodied with rich cherry flavors and aromas, enhanced by hints of oak vanilla.  
*Nero D'Avola, Cantine Paolini, "Gurgo" 2006 Sicilia* 8.50  
 Medium-bodied with intense luscious fruit, dark-chocolate flavors and well-integrated tannins.
